

Promoting Health Rights and Access to Medicines in Europe II

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Sustainable access to medicines and vaccines remains an issue in a number of European Union Member States, especially pertaining to the sustainability of public health systems. Such issues are notably due to a research and development model which incentivises innovation through monopoly rights.

Simultaneously, the use of [AI in healthcare poses](#) its own set of specific risks, which oftentimes policy makers and other stakeholders are unfamiliar with, despite AI being a key interest for the EU.

Health Action International's Promoting Health Rights and Access to Medicines in Europe 2 (PHRAME II) project will build on our previous 2023 project and aims to advance policies that put the health and well-being of patients first. We do this by focusing on three mutually supportive (and interlinked) themes:

- Equitable Access to Affordable Medicines
- Artificial Intelligence and Health
- Democratisation of Medicines Policy
